What is the IUSP?

Although German as a foreign language has become less commonly spoken among students around the world, students' interest in getting to know Germany and Europe during their studies has not diminished. Only a small number of German universities offer courses in English that would meet this interest while at the same time ensuring an academic level fully recognized by universities abroad. The IUSP has been designed to fill this gap.

An intensive German Language Course with a total of 120 hours is an essential part of the program. Participants are encouraged to attend regular university classes in German in order to become acquainted with their structure, strengthen personal German comprehension, and to get to know German students!

Target Audience

Undergraduate students from all over the world who are interested in German and European economics, politics, culture, psychology etc., and who want to get to know Germany and the German language within the context of an academic semester abroad, without missing out on classes (and credits) at their home university.

Academic Curriculum

German Language Courses:

• offered at 3 levels (beginner, intermediate, advanced)

German Culture Course:

• German History, Politics, Society and Economy

Contact Hours / Credits

- 120 hours German Language Course
- 56 hours German Culture Course
- 48 hours seminar (class plus tutorial)
- 36 hours conversation class (optional)

A standard IUSP course load consists of the intensive German Language Course plus the German Culture Course, and two seminars.

Credits will be issued in European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) points, which can be easily converted into other credit systems.

Cultural Program

In addition to the regular study program, the IUSP program fee also covers an interesting cultural program with weekend excursions to important historical and cultural sites, e.g. Frankfurt, Berlin, Weimar, Eisenach, Dresden, Nürnberg, Köln, Heidelberg, München, Hamburg.

Beginning and Duration of Program

The academic calendar has been adapted to international standards. Students will be able to return to their home campus and continue their studies without missing the semester following their semester in Germany.

Spring Term: Mid-February until June Fall Term: End of August until December

IUSP participants can enroll for one or two semesters.

Registration Deadline

December 15 for the Spring Term of the following year June 15 for the Fall Term

Expenses

Program fee includes

- the German Language Course,
- the German Culture Course,
- a conversation course (optional),
- two seminars, as well as
- the cultural program,
- accommodations (single room in student dorm),
- a meal subsidy,
- a ticket for free public transport within Hessen,
- the semester administration fee.
