
**Tuesday, May 16** Day with Careli Tours – Orientation to Nicaragua (Lodging: Las Mercedes)

#### Wisconsin/Nicaragua Partners Therapy Dressing Project

The Therapy Dressing project is carried out by volunteer staff in coordination with local Doctors referrals to provide garments for burn and plastic surgery patients.
